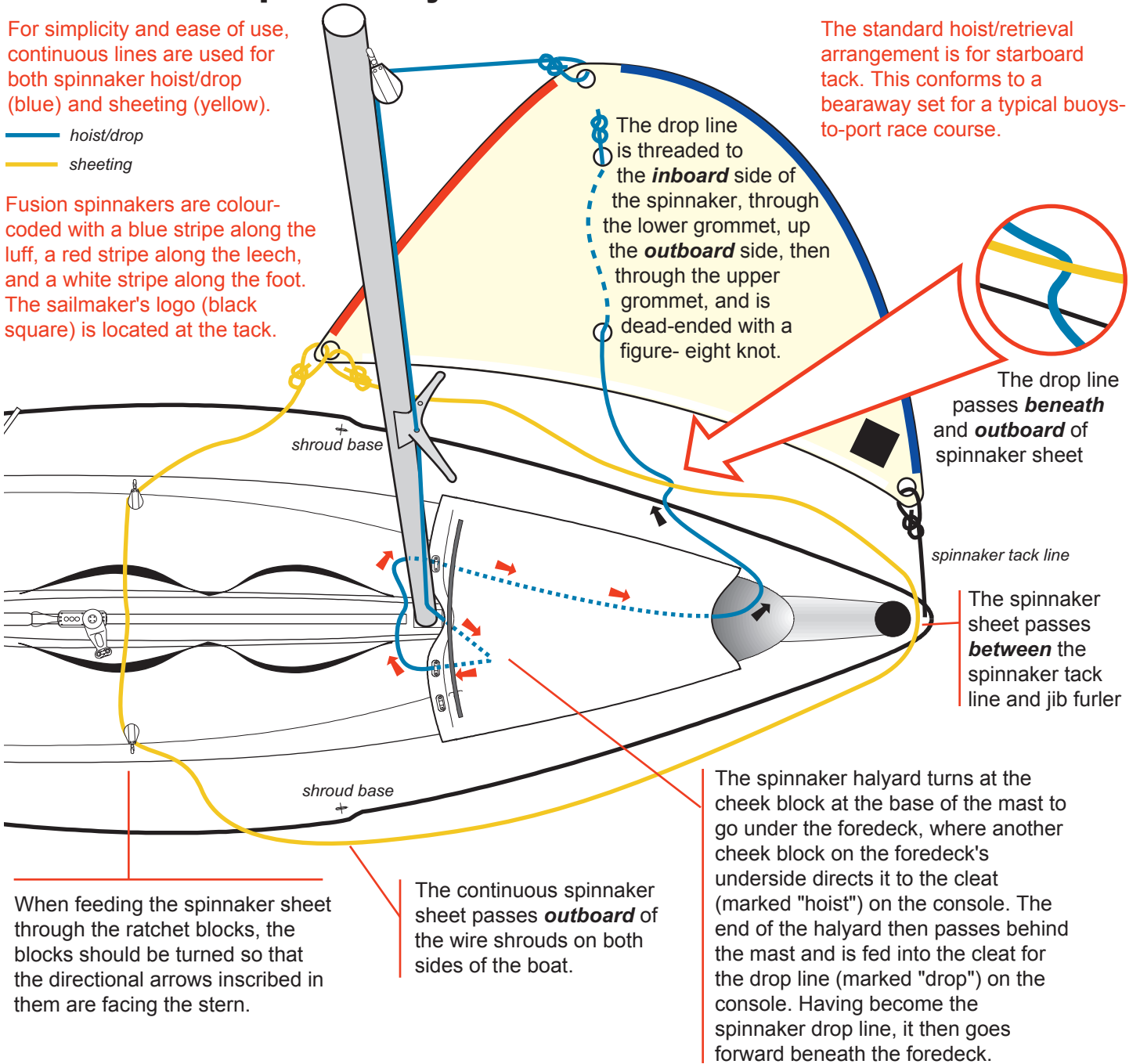


The Fusion 15 spinnaker system

For simplicity and ease of use, continuous lines are used for both spinnaker hoist/drop (blue) and sheeting (yellow).

— hoist/drop
— sheeting

Fusion spinnakers are colour-coded with a blue stripe along the luff, a red stripe along the leech, and a white stripe along the foot. The sailmaker's logo (black square) is located at the tack.



The spinnaker monkey

The spinnaker monkey attaches to the port shroud and the spinnaker halyard and runs freely on each. When the spinnaker is hoisted, it climbs the rigging with it. When the spinnaker is lowered, the monkey returns to deck level and keeps the halyard clear of the jib.

Note: when lowering the spinnaker, it helps to first unfurl the jib, to avoid having the halyard of the lowered spinnaker wrap around the jib aloft as the sail is unfurled.
